## **Elise Trouble shooting Guide**

Important Note: For any unusual problem 'System reset' your radio (see page 18 of Instruction book). if the topography of where you live means you get poor FM or mobile phone service, your DAB coverage may be affected.

1. Radio cuts out.     Try this link	• Make sure the aerial is fully extended. Move the radio/aerial to get maximum signal strength or minimum

Try the radio on mains.</li> <li>Check the digital radio (DAB) coverage in your area using the link – www.ukdigitalradio.com/coverage/search/default.asp and your postcode.</li> <li>If the coverage is poor try this link</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If the coverage is poor try this link <u>http://www.ukdigitalradio.com/advice/toptips/</u></li> <li>The type of building and surroundings can seriously affect the DAB reception. Sizeable concrete and metal work in the building (e.g. Block of flats, shopping centre, near or under a bridge, thermal insulation with metal foil in the loft) can considerably reduce the signal strength.</li> <li>Under these circumstances, an outdoor aerial is required for optimum reception.</li> </ul>
2. Presetting station into the memory.	Tune in the required station then press and <b>hold</b> preset button until display shows "stored"
<ul><li>3. Recalling a preset station does not work.</li><li>4. Display starts to fade, sound</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Momentarily press the required preset button and wait for few seconds. <u>Do not</u> press and hold the preset button.</li> <li>These are typical low battery symptoms (if using on</li> </ul>
breaking up, signal strength shows low or switches off itself.	batteries) try a set of new batteries.

5. Can not get BBC Sports Extra, display shows "Not Available".	<ul> <li>This radio station is not transmitting all the time. Transmitting details can be found by visiting the following links.</li> <li><u>http://www.bbc.co.uk/5livesportsextra</u></li> <li>Click on Schedule.</li> </ul>
6. Batteries are not lasting long.	<ul> <li>Use only alkaline batteries. Zinc-Carbon or rechargeable batteries do not last as long.</li> <li>It consumes more current on FM. Due to this reason weak batteries may work on DAB but not on FM. Therefore, battery life is considerably less on FM.</li> <li>Whenever possible use mains electricity.</li> </ul>
<ul><li>7. Works ok on DAB, cuts out</li><li>(switches off) on FM.</li></ul>	See above
8. Losing presets.	<ul> <li>See 2 &amp; 3 above.</li> <li>When recalling a station from preset simply press and release preset button. Do NOT press and HOLD the preset.</li> </ul>
