1. Radio cuts out or shows 'Services not available'. <u>http://www.ukdigitalradio.co</u> m/advice/toptips/	 Make sure the aerial is fully extended. Reposition the radio/aerial to get maximum signal strength (ref. To page 9-Signal strength display). Make sure batteries are not flat (if using batteries). Try radio on mains (using mains adaptor). Check the digital radio (DAB) coverage in your area using the link – www.ukdigitalradio.com/coverage/search/default.asp and your postcode. The type of building and surroundings can seriously affect the DAB reception. Sizeable concrete and metal work in the building (e.g. Block of flats, shopping centre, near or under a bridge, thermal insulation with metal foil in the loft) can considerably reduce the signal strength.
